OVERVIEW

Crumpled Paper Artworks, made by crumpling paper into shapes and later superimposing them on digital environments, is different from other known paper art styles like origami, pop-ups, solid geometry based paper engineering, relief cutouts or papier-maché. Kunal's paper crumpling style is, in his own words "like gesture drawing as a paper sculpture," and when he is creating, he relies heavily on the pareidolia phenomenon (the tendency to perceive a specific, often meaningful image in a random or ambiguous visual pattern). The humble A4 print paper and craft glue can make magic when imagination comes to play!
